NOTICE OF RACE

Strangford Lough Yacht Club will be running The Frostie Series this Autumn at Whiterock on Saturdays from 19 September to 17 October.

Weather permitting, there will be two races each Saturday giving a total of 10 races. The first Warning Signal will be at 13.30 hrs. Scoring will be by the RRS low points system with racing being held in the area of SLYC race marks.

There will be classes for: IRC 1 (0.951 & over)
IRC 2 (0.950 & under)
NHC 1
NHC RS
Sonatas
RS Elite & Flying 15s

Classes may be split or amalgamated depending on the number of entries received.

The event is open to all Strangford Lough boats, however due to the current Covid 19 situation after sailing activities will in all likelihood not be available to participants.

A prize will be available to the boat in each class amalgamating the lowest points over the two races of each day.

We are sorry that we are unable to offer the usual social programme however we warmly welcome you to the series and, tides permitting, you are welcome to make use of the pontoon for socialising on your own craft after racing.

At present we are unable to offer a prize giving dinner.

SLYC will endeavour to help arrange suitable moorings in Whiterock Bay for visiting yachts whose owners request this facility, provided their entries are received by Friday 11 September. Yacht owners borrowing moorings do so at their own risk as all are privately owned and are not maintained by SLYC.

Entry Fee: £50 (discounted to £20 due to Coronavirus pandemic) Participants are requested to enter before 11 September as late entries seriously delay the production of the race results.
