1. Each student is allocated a numbered armband, which is his or her number for the season. They must put it on prior to going on the water and hand it back in immediately they come ashore
2. Ensure your child has suitable gear for sailing, wetsuit and wind breaker suitable tight fitting footwear that can get wet and a snug fitting buoyancy aid, hat and sunscreen. If the sailor is not properly attired (particularly if the buoyancy aid is inadequate) then they shall not be allowed on the water.
3. Whilst the club provides safety cover you should be aware of the risks that can occur with sailing activities even with adequate safety procedures – unavoidable accidents can happen
4. Sailing may be cancelled on the day if conditions are deemed to be unsuitable. Parents **must** ensure that sailing is taking place before they leave their child on the club premises.
5. Mobile phones must not be used in the changing rooms
