NOTICE OF RACE

Strangford Lough Yacht Club will be running The Frostie Series this Autumn at Whiterock on Saturdays from 18 September to 16 October.

Weather permitting, there will be two races each Saturday giving a total of 10 races. The first Warning Signal will be at 13.30 hrs. Scoring will be by the RRS low points system.

There will be classes for:

- IRC 1 (0.950 & over)
- IRC 2 (0.949 & under)
- NHC 1
- NHC 2
- NHC 1 Restricted Sail
- NHC 2 Restricted Sail
- Sonatas
- RS Elite

Please note that the above classes may be split or amalgamated depending on the number of entries received.

Prizes will be awarded for the best performance in every race in each class. These will be presented in the Clubhouse after racing each Saturday when the Bar will be open and soup will be served. (See **Covid Guidelines**)

Trophies for the winning boat and prizes for the second 2 boats in each class in the series will be presented in the Clubhouse after the final days sailing on 16th October .

SLYC will endeavour to arrange suitable moorings in Whiterock Bay for visiting yachts whose owners request this facility, provided their entries are received by Friday 11th September. Yacht owners borrowing moorings do so at their own risk as all are privately owned and are not maintained by SLYC.

Entry Fee: £50 (discounted to £40 for entries received by Friday 11th September) Participants are requested to enter before 15 September and take advantage of the discounted entry fee, as late entries seriously delay the production of the race results.
